

Christ Knows All Those Loved by the Father

I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (Matthew 7:23).

Many serious, sober and sincere Christians believe God's love extends equally to all persons ever born.

John 3:16 is their proof text.

As has been proven in the past several posts, the mind and will of God the Father, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit are one in purpose, intention and endeavor.

If Jesus Christ never knew the false, carnal professing Christians, then neither did the Father and Spirit know the false, carnal professing Christians to whom He was addressing.

Herein lays the dilemma.

How is it possible the Triune God loved these false professors, yet did not 'know' them?

Certainly the Lord knows those He loves. Scripture states as much:

The Lord knoweth them that are his (2 Timothy 2:19).

The Lord knows His people whom He calls His beloved sheep (John 10:14).

They are His own whom He loves unto the end (John 13:1).

They are the same ones given Him by the Father, for whom He prays and for whom He makes atonement (John 17).

They are the same ones so loved by the Father, those whom He chose to save (Ephesians 1:3-7).

They are the same ones so loved by Christ that He chose to lay down His life to save them (John 15:13).

They are the same one so loved by the Holy Spirit that the love of God is shed abroad in their hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given to them (Romans 5:5).

CONCLUSION: Those Christ never knew were never loved by the Father, Son or Holy Spirit.
